

## **PETERS TOWNSHIP SKATE PARK RULES**

- Peters Township Skate Park is a drug/alcohol/tobacco -free zone.
- Participants are strongly suggested to wear elbow pads, kneepads and a helmet at all times.
- Glass containers, food or beverages are not allowed on the skating surface (spills jeopardize the skaters).
- Deposit trash in provided receptacles.
- Graffiti and stickers are not allowed in the Skate Park.
- No loitering after facility is closed.
- An adult must accompany children under the age of 10.
- Pets are prohibited in the Skate Park.
- Outside obstacles and modifications to the elements are prohibited.
- Bicycle pegs are not permitted.
- Check your equipment to be sure it is safe.
- Check the ramp and features for safety before use.
- Skate within your ability.
- Do not use the skate park if ice, snow or other unsafe conditions are present.
- Please report all injuries or damage immediately.
- Peters Township is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- All other Peters Township park rules and ordinances apply.

### **Skate at Your Own Risk**

There is an inherent risk in the participation of skate park activities. Users of the skate park, by participation, accept the risks inherent in such participation of which the ordinary prudent person is or should be aware. Users have a duty to exercise good judgment and act in a responsible manner while using the skate park element and obey all oral, or written warnings, or both, prior to or during participation, or both.

### **Peters Township Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to:**

- Close the skate park for any circumstances deemed necessary.
- Restrict use of the skate park and/or ask persons to leave the skate park or suspend individuals from the Skate Park if any of the rules are not followed or inappropriate behavior.
