Garbage/Recycling Information

- Garbage/Recycling is picked up once a week and must be placed curbside by 6:00 AM of your scheduled day.
- No garbage outside of your Township-issued garbage cart will be accepted, except for two bulk items per month (first full pickup week of the month).
- No recycling outside of your Township-issued recycling cart will be accepted.
- Residents may obtain an additional garbage cart(s) for an annually adjusted fee directly through Waste Management. **Call 1-800-866-4460 to order additional carts and service.**

Materials Accepted In Your Recycling Cart

- **Metal:** Aluminum cans, bi-metal cans, steel, and tin food cans
- **Plastics:** Screw-top plastic bottles, jars & jugs (labeled #1 or #2). Plastic caps are allowed if secured tightly to a plastic bottle.
- **Plastic Tubs:** Acceptable plastic tubs have a snap on lid and hold food such as yogurt, cottage cheese, cream cheese, and butter.
- **Glass:** Bottles & jars
- **Paper:** Magazines, advertising inserts, junk mail, phone books, newspaper, envelopes, catalogs, paperback books, and computer paper.
- **Cardboard:** Cardboard boxes and sheets of cardboard.
- **Paperboard Boxes:** Cereal, dry foods, and tissue boxes. Please remove any plastic film and flatten.
- **Paper Towel Rolls**
- **Pizza Boxes:** Please remove paper and any food waste and flatten.

Materials Not Accepted In Your Recycling Cart

- **No #3, #4, #5*, #6, or #7 Plastics** (*#5 see Plastic Tubs above)
- **No Plastic Bags** of any kind, including blue bags. Plastic bags may be recycled at your nearest Giant Eagle location.
- **No Berry Containers** & No Clam Shell Containers, No Garbage or Food Waste, Shredded Paper, Ceramics, Styrofoam or Fast Food Wrappers, Loose Plastic Caps, Metal Lids, Aluminum Pie Pans or Aluminum Foil, Toilet Paper Rolls, Cartons (Milk, Almond/Soy Milk, Cream, & Orange Juice Containers), Paper Envelopes with Plastic Windows or Plastic/Bubble Wrap Lined Envelopes

Electronics/Household Hazardous Waste

Cardboard Compactor

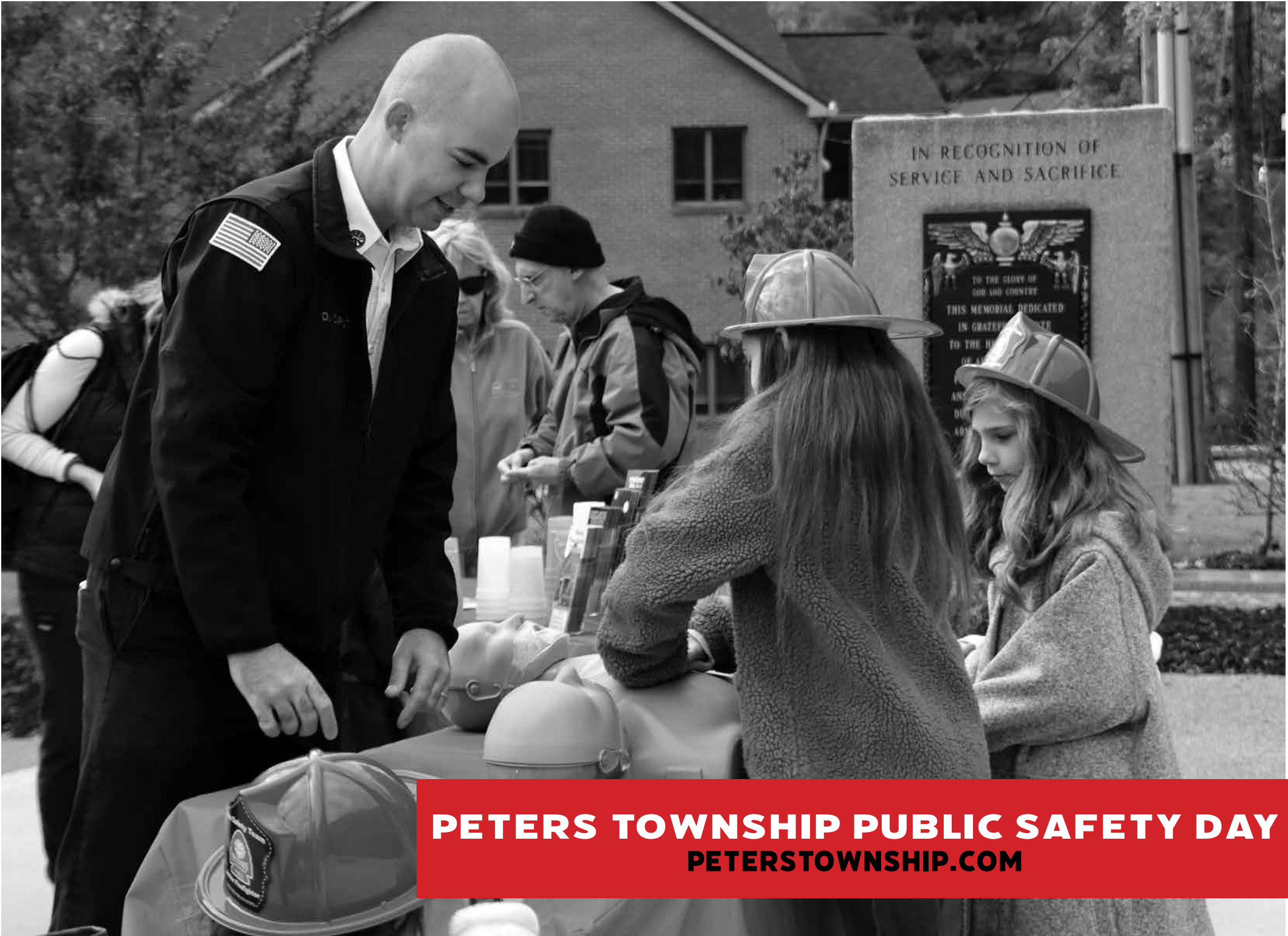

PERMITS

Permits are required for:

- Accessory buildings/Additions
- Building/Remodeling
- Demolition or removal of a building
- Fences/ Pools
- Signs - temporary or permanent
- Solicitation (call 724-942-5030)
- Tent sales, special events and outdoor storage of seasonal displays in commercial districts
- Burning - builders and developers only
- Change in watercourse or drain, ditch or stream
- Grading (excavation or filling)
- Home occupations - An occupancy permit is required to use your home for a business. Such businesses must meet certain township conditions.
- Occupancy of a building - Occupancy permits are required for each new occupant or tenant of a building or portion of a building.
- Road encroachment - any work done on or in a public right-of-way (724-941-6161)

ORDINANCES

The Peters Township Code of Ordinances can be viewed in its entirety at peterstownship.com.

BURNING: All open burning is permitted on four days per week – Wednesdays, Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays – and only from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. Fires must be attended to at all times. Noxious trash burning is not permitted. No burning in the commercial or industrial districts of the township is allowed. Builders and developers must obtain permits.

DOG CONTROL: Dogs are not permitted to run at large. Dogs over three months must have a Washington County dog license. No more than two mature dogs may be kenneled outdoors in a residential district. Frequent or continued noise by barking dogs is policed by the animal control officer. Pet owners must clean up after their animals in all township parks, including the Arrowhead Trail.

PARKING: No parking is permitted on the streets between 2:00 and 6:00 a.m. Parking in cul-de-sacs is prohibited at all times. Violators are subject to a fine of up to \$50. For emergency situations, contact the police department.

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE: The Township has a property maintenance code to prevent and enforce maintenance issues. If you have concerns with properties not being maintained, please contact the Planning Department.

OFF-ROAD VEHICLES: All motor-driven vehicles used for off-street recreational purposes in the township must be registered at the police department. Vehicles cannot be ridden within 100 feet of a property line or where dust is visible from 50 feet away or if a property is less than 2 acres.

SNOW EMERGENCIES: During a snow emergency, no vehicle may be parked, abandoned or left unattended on any street or right-of-way.

SOLICITATION: House-to-house solicitation is not permitted without a permit from the Police Department. The permit contains the solicitor's photo. Residents may sign up on the No Knock List to prevent solicitors from visiting their home. Details are available at peterstownship.com/noknocklist

STORM WATER ORDINANCE: It shall be unlawful for a property owner to divert and/or concentrate storm water onto an adjacent property other than into a natural watercourse, channel, storm drainage easement or public storm sewer system.

SUBDIVISION: The creation of any new lot, parcel, or shifting of lot lines requires township approval of a surveyed drawing.

WEAPONS: It is unlawful for any person to discharge any prohibited weapons in the township. Prohibited weapons shall be any weapon discharging a single missile projectile by force, including rifles, pistols, BB guns, air guns, air pistols, spring guns, crossbows, sling shots or any other weapon which impels a pellet with a force that can reasonably be expected to cause bodily harm. Hunting is, however, permitted in designated areas ONLY.

ZONING: Ordinances establish zoning districts where only certain uses are permitted and establish such criteria as height of buildings, setbacks from streets, side and rear lot lines, etc.

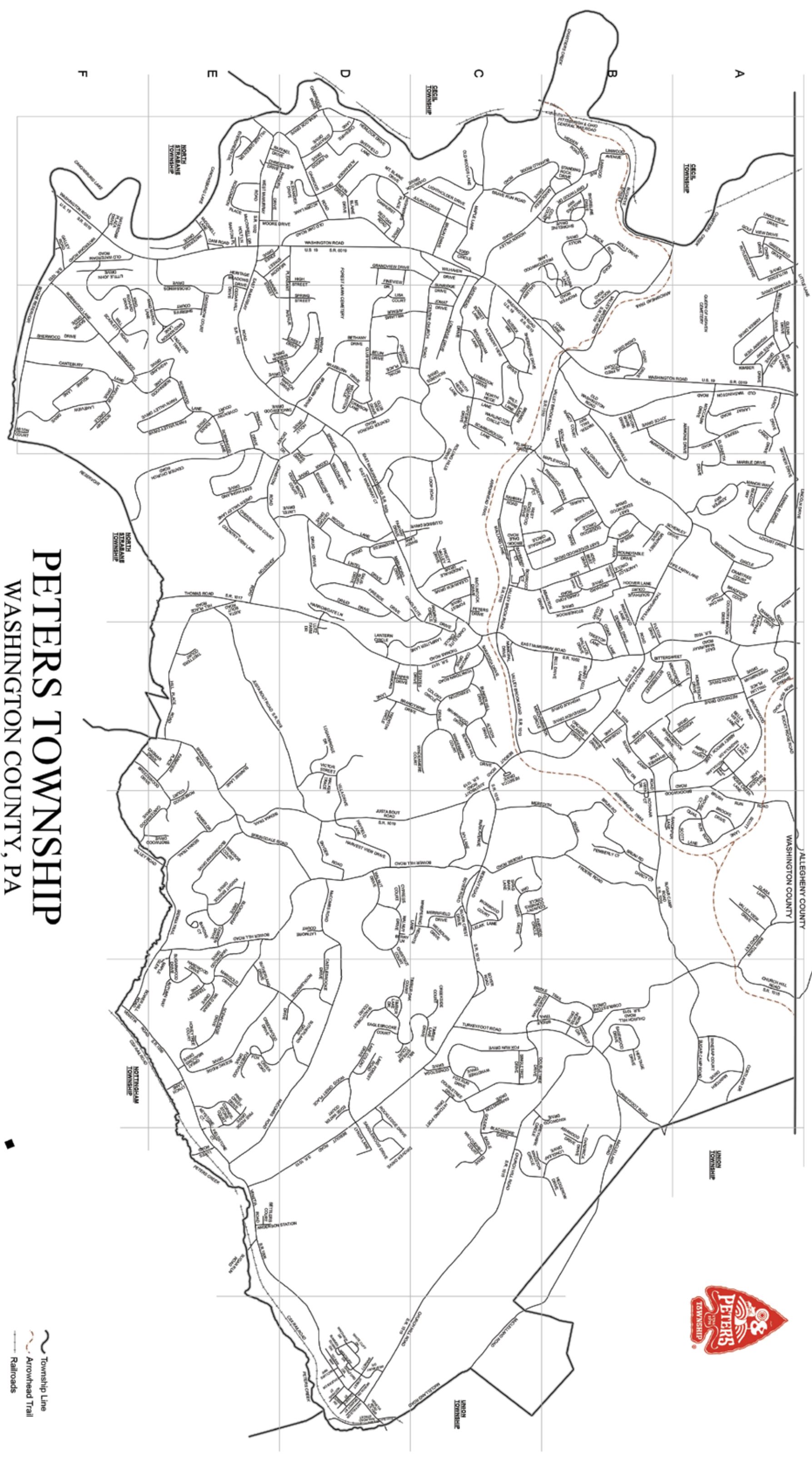

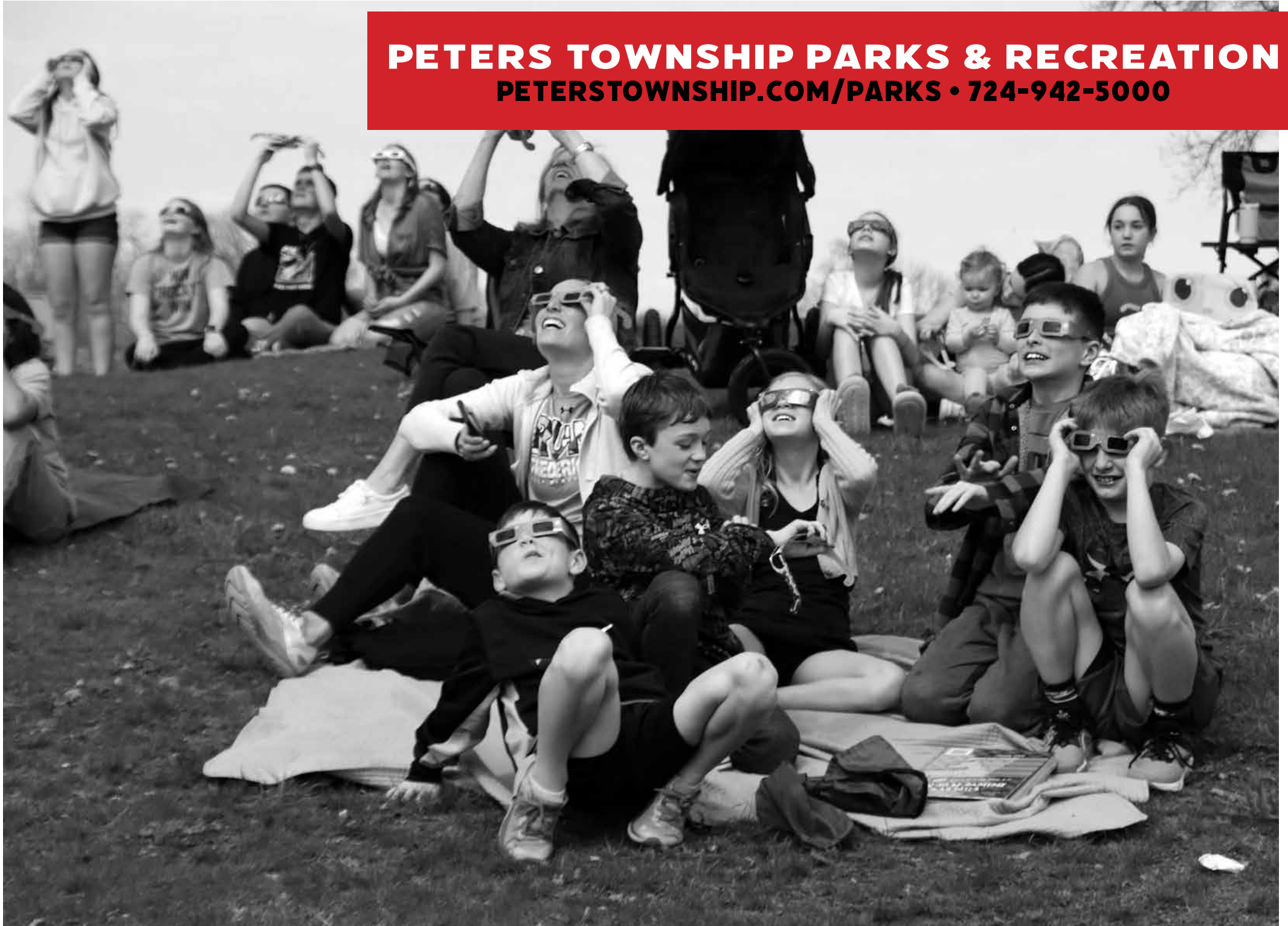

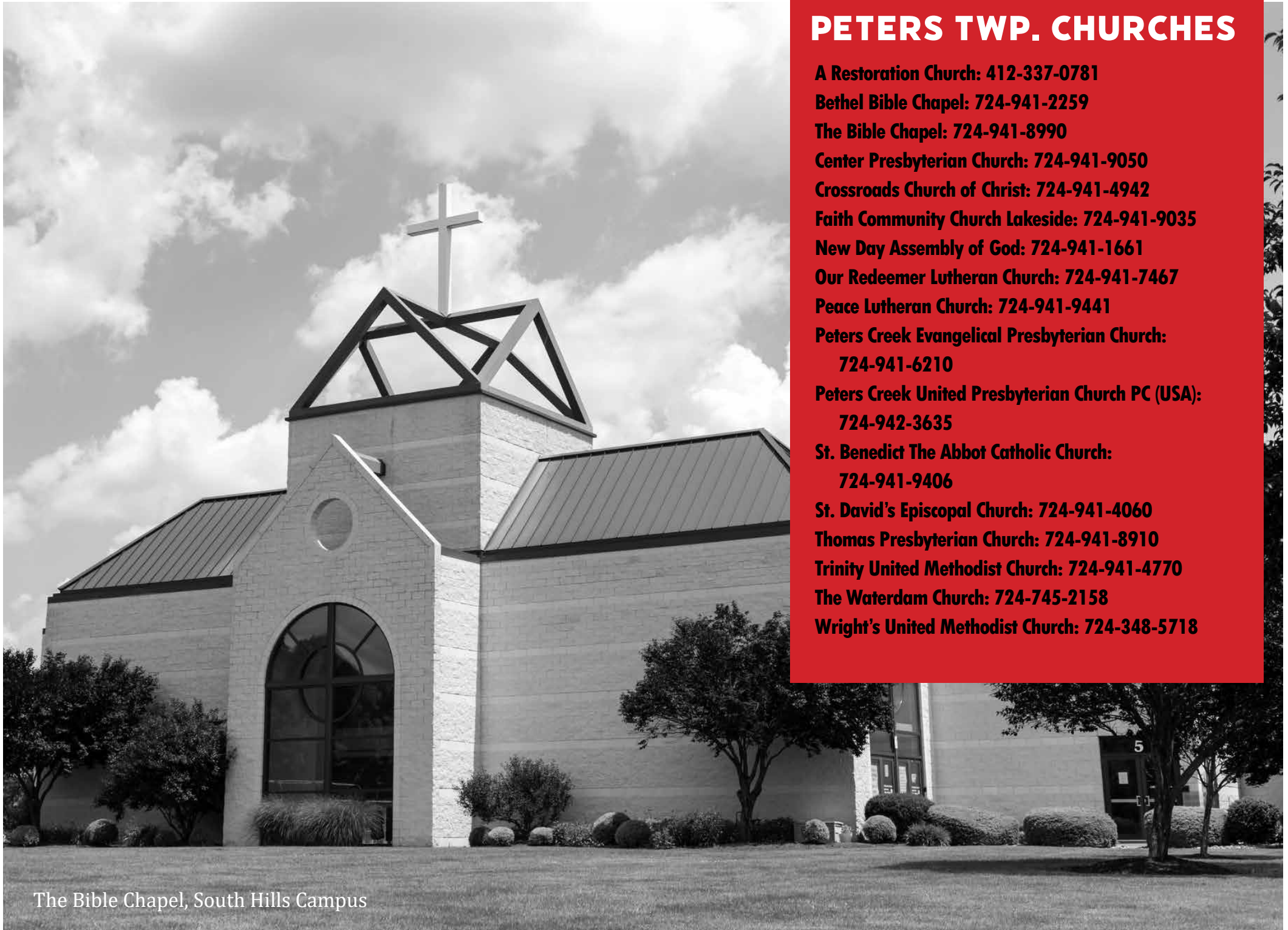
