Garbage/Recycling Information

- Garbage/Recycling is picked up once a week and must be placed curbside by 6:00 AM of your scheduled day.
- No garbage outside of your Township-issued garbage cart will be accepted, except for two bulk items per month (first full pickup week of the month).
- No recycling outside of your Township-issued cart will be accepted.
- Residents may obtain an additional garbage or recycling cart for an annually adjusted fee directly through Waste Management. **Call 1-800-866-4460 to order additional carts and service.**

Materials Accepted In Your Recycling Cart

- **Metal:** Aluminum cans, bi-metal cans, steel, and tin food cans
- **Plastics:** Screw-top plastic bottles, jars & jugs (labeled #1 or #2). Plastic caps are allowed if secured tightly to a plastic bottle.
- **Plastic Tubs:** Acceptable plastic tubs have a snap on lid and hold food such as yogurt, cottage cheese, cream cheese, and butter.
- **Paper:** Magazines, advertising inserts, junk mail, phone books, newspaper, envelopes, catalogs, paperback books, and computer paper.
- **Cardboard:** Cardboard boxes and sheets of cardboard.
- **Paperboard Boxes:** Cereal, dry foods, and tissue boxes. Please remove any plastic film and flatten.
- **Paper Towel Rolls**
- **Pizza Boxes:** Please remove paper and any food waste and flatten.

Materials Not Accepted In Your Recycling Cart

- **No Glass** of Any Kind.
- **No #3, #4, #5*, #6, or #7 Plastics** (*#5 see Plastic Tubs above)
- **No Plastic Bags** of any kind, including blue bags. Plastic bags may be recycled at your nearest Giant Eagle location.
- **No Berry Containers & No Clam Shell Containers, No Garbage or Food Waste, Shredded Paper, Ceramics, Styrofoam or Fast Food Wrappers, Loose Plastic Caps, Metal Lids, Aluminum Pie Pans or Aluminum Foil, Toilet Paper Rolls, Cartons (Milk, Almond/Soy Milk, Cream, & Orange Juice Containers), Paper Envelopes with Plastic Windows or Plastic/Bubble Wrap Lined Envelopes**

Electronics/Household Hazardous Waste

Cardboard Compactor

PERMITS

Permits are required for:

- Accessory buildings/Additions
- Building/Remodeling
- Demolition or removal of a building
- Fences/ Pools
- Signs - temporary or permanent
- Solicitation (call 724-942-5030)
- Tent sales, special events and outdoor storage of seasonal displays in commercial districts
- Burning - builders and developers only
- Change in watercourse or drain, ditch or stream
- Grading (excavation or filling)
- Home occupations - An occupancy permit is required to use your home for a business. Such businesses must meet certain township conditions.
- Occupancy of a building - Occupancy permits are required for each new occupant or tenant of a building or portion of a building.
- Road encroachment - any work done on or in a public right-of-way (724-941-6161)

E-Bikes Rules/Regulations

E-bikes, or electric bicycles, are pedal-powered bikes that are equipped with an electric motor. In Peters Township, an e-bike is defined as a bicycle that weighs no more than 100 pounds, has two or three wheels with a diameter of more than 11 inches, and is powered by a motor rated at no more than 750 watts. E-bikes can reach speeds of up to 20 miles per hour on flat surfaces when using the motor alone.



Rules Regarding Riding E-bikes and Electrically Motorized Devices

The new rules for riding e-bikes in Peters Township include the following key points:

- E-bikes must remain on paved pathways at all times in public parks, including the Arrowhead Trail.
- Riders must wear helmets if they are under 21 years of age.
- E-bikes can only be operated by individuals who are at least 16 years old.
- The maximum speed limit for e-bikes on park pathways is 15 miles per hour.
- Riders must yield the right-of-way to pedestrians and maintain a safe distance.
- E-bikes may only be used in public parks from dawn to dusk.

Additionally, electrically motorized devices such as electric scooters, electric motorcycles, one wheels, or other electrically powered devices without pedals are prohibited in all Peters Township parks, open spaces, and trails.

Comprehensive Plan

Over the course of 2025 and into 2026, Peters Township will be embarking on a process to update its Comprehensive Plan. This is a process that is required to be done by the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code approximately every 10 years and Peters is now due for an update to its Comprehensive Plan. To aid Township staff, HRG, Inc. has been selected as the consultant to help develop the Update to Peters Township Comprehensive Plan.

The purpose of the Comprehensive Plan is to not just highlight past and present land use trends, but to also provide a blueprint for land use patterns, infrastructure investment, and many other policy initiatives. The Comprehensive Plan will look at a combination of public comments, demographic and market trends, the natural and physical landscape, existing and proposed infrastructure, and many other aspects of the community to develop several courses of actions to guide the development of the community in a clear, concise, and orderly manner.

Peters Township has established a website, peterstownship.com/compplan, where we will post information on the Comprehensive Plan including its progress, supporting information, and upcoming events/meetings.
